The movie is a powerful, true, story of how Mexican Catholics fought for their freedom of religion in Mexico. The assault on religious freedom began when Mexico adopted a Constitution in 1917 which contained strong anticlerical language, setting the stage for organized resistance against the government. The film is a chronicle of the "Cristeros War" (1926-1929); an important event largely forgotten in the USA, a war by the people of Mexico against the atheistic Mexican government. Snacks will be served -- come and enjoy a FREE movie, and learn the story of brave patriots standing up for religious freedom.
