

The Gospel: John 15:1-8

- ❑ Today is the final class of our parish Formation Program. We welcome Mr. Lucas Pollice, Director of Adult Religious Education for the Diocese of Fort Worth as our instructor today. The time to get your Baptismal/Annulment Records is now, and the date for our Confirmation will be determined very soon. If you CANNOT obtain your records, (church closed, records lost etc.) then, you can write out the attestation that you were baptized at such and such a date (with witnesses signatures attached if possible) and we will proceed accordingly. Please see Julia Smead TODAY if you need to write out such an attestation. Remember -- the goal is to get you INTO the Church, and I know that Monsignor Steenson, Bishop Vann, and the other Catholic Authorities will do all that they can to facilitate this.
- ❑ All the clergy in the Ordinariate program in Fort Worth have received phone calls from Bishop Vann and Fr. Hurd. All "rescripts" (permissions for Ordinations) have been granted by our Holy Father in Rome. Ordination dates are being set by Bishop Vann and Msgr. Steenson, and we can anticipate our first Mass as the fully Catholic Community of St. Timothy's Church at the end of June or early in July. Our Confirmation date is being set by Bishop Vann as well.
- ❑ St. Mary's celebrates Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament every Wednesday after the 7 p.m. Mass in the Church. Also, the Blessed Sacrament is exposed for Adoration every Thursday from 12:30 to 4:00 p.m. in the Chapel. Why not plan to visit our Saviour in the Most Holy Sacrament of the Altar sometime this Easter Season.
