## ANNOUNCEMENTS

- ❑ Our Parish Formation classes continue today following mass and run through Easter. We have been granted an accelerated program so the classes are not much different in length than the inquirers classes we have all been through.
- ❑ This Wednesday, February 22, is Ash Wednesday. This year there will be two masses for Ash Wednesday -- one at 7:30 a.m. in the Church, and one at 9:30 a.m. in the rectory chapel. The advantage of these times is that we are able to make a Christian Witness to the day at the beginning of the day itself (I often felt rather odd when having our main service after dark, when the day was spent!) For those unable to attend either of these masses, St. Mary's will have their masses at noon and 6 p.m. (with one at 8 p.m. in Spanish). Starting today, there will be copies of the handout "Making a Lenten Rule" available in the back of the church. In it are suggestions on how we can KEEP a good Lent. You are encouraged to take one home, pray about it and return it in the collection plate next Sunday
- ❑ This year we will join our friends at St. Mary's at their Friday evening Stations of the Cross at 7 p.m. Please plan to keep a Holy and Focussed Lent by walking the Way of the Cross with our Lord on Friday nights.
- ❑ **Please Note:** For non profit tax reasons, our church will be temporarily under the 501c3 tax I.D. of St. Mary's Church, and they will set up a sub account for our offerings.
