The Gospel: John 12:20-33

Now there were some Greeks among those who had come up to worship at the feast. They came to Philip, who was from Bethsaida in Galilee, and asked him, “Sir, we would like to see Jesus.” Philip went and told Andrew; then Andrew and Philip went and told Jesus. Jesus answered them, “The hour has come for the Son of Man to be glorified. Amen, amen, I say to you, unless a grain of wheat falls to the ground and dies, it remains just a grain of wheat; but if it dies, it produces much fruit. Whoever loves his life loses it, and whoever hates his life in this world will preserve it for eternal life. Whoever serves me must follow me, and where I am, there also will my servant be. The Father will honor whoever serves me. “I am troubled* now. Yet what should I say? ‘Father, save me from this hour’? But it was for this purpose that I came to this hour. Father, glorify your name.” Then a voice came from heaven, “I have glorified it and will glorify it again.” The crowd there heard it and said it was thunder; but others said, “An angel has spoken to him.” Jesus answered and said, “This voice did not come for my sake but for yours. Now is the time of judgment on this world; now the ruler of this world will be driven out. And when I am lifted up from the earth, I will draw everyone to myself.” He said this indicating the kind of death he would die. *Response: Praise be to Thee O Christ*


Announcements

- ❑ St. Timothy's parishioners are invited to join our host parish (St. Mary of the Assumption) for their Holy Week Services.
 - Maundy Thursday Mass, Foot Washing, and Procession at 7 p.m. with Watch before the Blessed Sacrament at the Altar of Repose until 10 p.m.
 - Good Friday, Liturgy at 7 p.m. (with Father Stainbrook hearing Confessions during the Liturgy -- last chance before Easter!!)
 - Holy Saturday, Great Vigil of Easter and Holy Baptism 8:30 p.m.
 - Easter Sunday -- Easter Egg Hunt at 11:30 a.m.
 - **We will have our regular St. Timothy's Solemn Mass of Easter at 2 p.m.**
- ❑ The Parish Office will be closed Monday April 6th (NOT for Father Stainbrook's birthday, but to allow the staff to rest after Easter!) and also on Tuesday April 7th. We will have our regular Wednesday Mass at 9:30 a.m. followed by Bible Study on April 8th.
