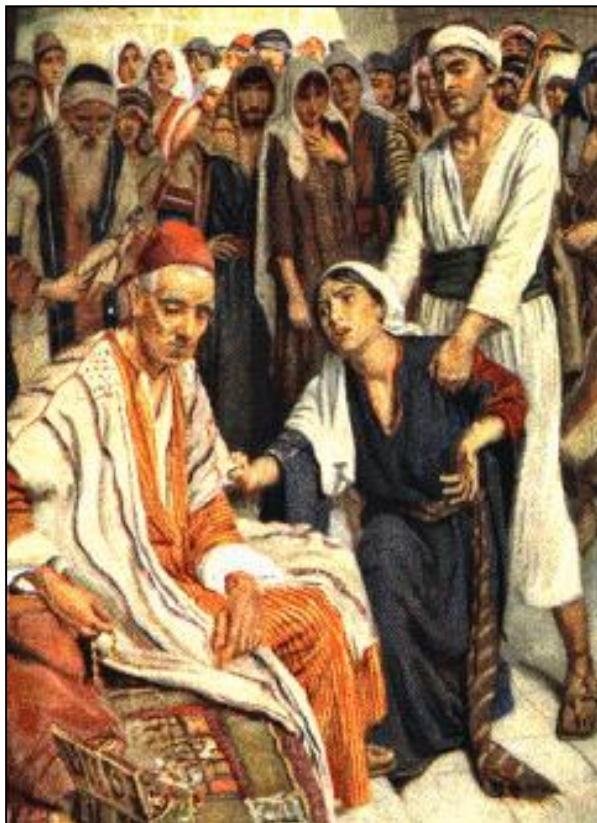

Almighty ever-living God, grant that we may always conform our will to yours and serve your majesty in sincerity of heart. Through our Lord Jesus Christ, your Son, who lives and reigns with you in the unity of the Holy Spirit, one God, for ever and ever. *Response: Amen.*

### *The Lesson: 2 Timothy 3:14 – 4:2*

But continue thou in the things which thou hast learned and hast been assured of, knowing of whom thou hast learned them; and that from a child thou hast known the holy scriptures, which are able to make thee wise unto salvation through faith which is in Christ Jesus. All scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness: that the man of God may be perfect, thoroughly furnished unto all good works. I charge thee therefore before God, and the Lord Jesus Christ, who shall judge the quick and the dead at his appearing and his kingdom; preach the word; be instant in season, out of season; reprove, rebuke, exhort with all longsuffering and doctrine. *Response: Thanks be to God.*

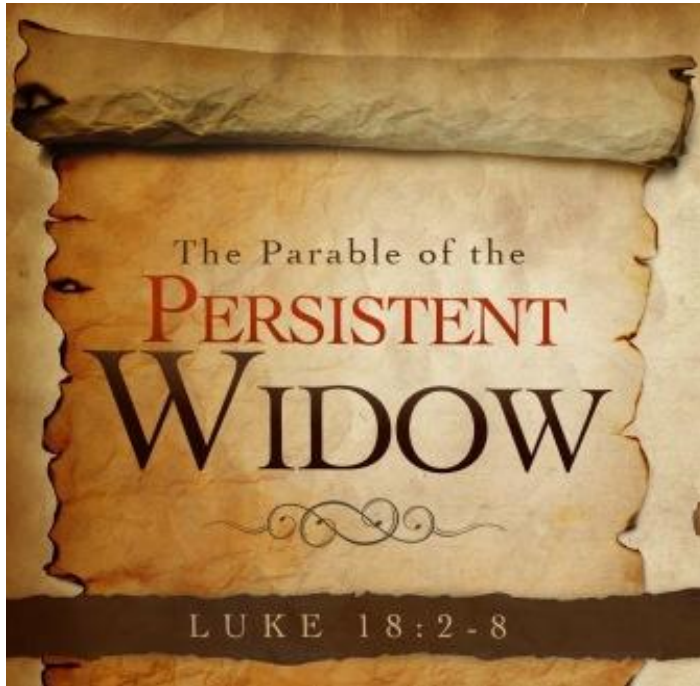

- ❑ The Clergy of the American Ordinariate will be on their annual retreat/business meeting in Tampa Florida next week (October 21st to the 25th). Our regular schedule resumes Sunday, October 27th with the 2 p.m. Solemn Mass in the Church.
