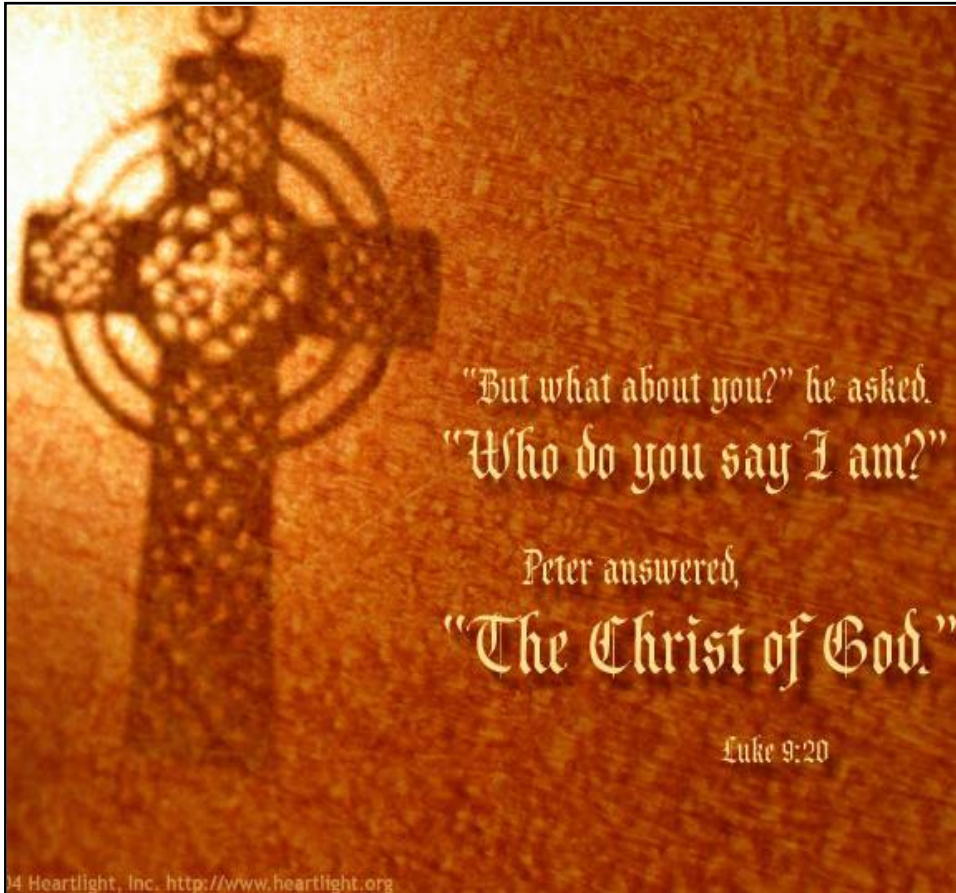

### *The Gospel: Luke 9:18-24*

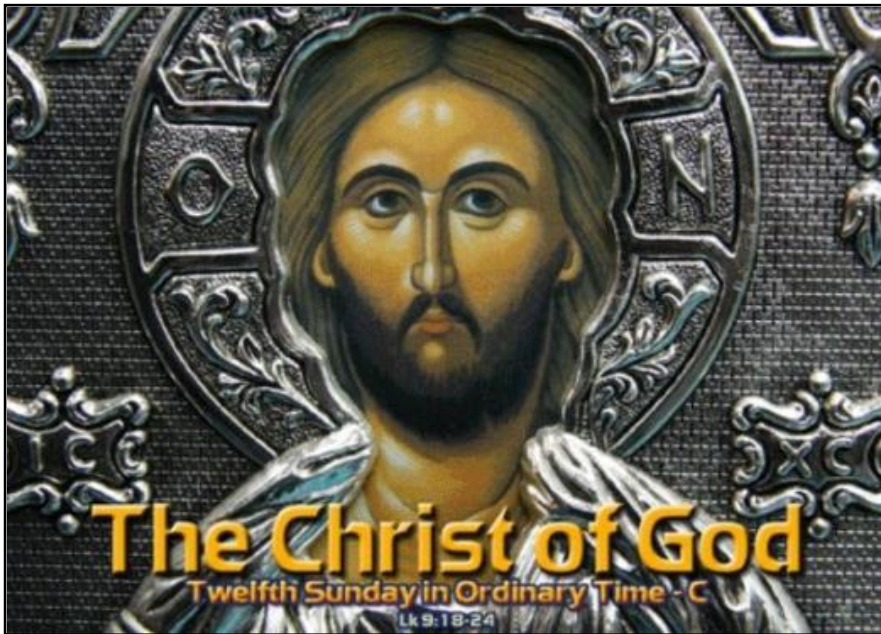
