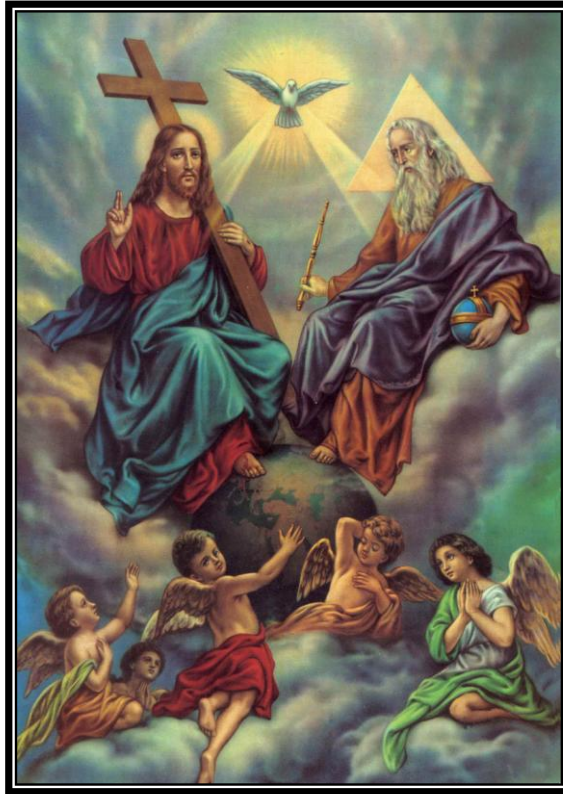

Hymnals are available for less than \$20 and Tomi has offered to order them. The ultimate plan is to eliminate the cost of printing music each week. We must continue printing the bulletins each week and parishioners are encouraged to help with that expense. Please give us your thoughts.
- ❑ Very historically important ordinations for the diocese, the Church in the United States and the Universal Church will be occurring this month. Saturday morning, June 30<sup>th</sup>, at 9:00 AM at St. Elizabeth Ann Seton in Keller, the following deacons will be ordained priests for the Ordinariate of the Chair of St. Peter: Christopher Stainbrook, Charles Hough III, Charles Hough IV, Timothy Perkins, Joshua Whitfield, and Mark Cannaday. Msgr. Jeffrey Steenson, the Ordinary, will be present at this event, and will be calling these candidates to Orders shortly.
